2 h pm Montréal – Departure from the « Palais des Congrès de Montréal »

This tour includes:

- ✓ Overview of **Old Montréal**, the historic heart of the city.
- ✓ Travel through time by visiting **Place d'Armes**, the **Old Port** as well as **City Hall** and the **Bonsecours Market**.
- ✓ You will see the **downtown**, from the bustle of Ste-Catherine Street to stately McGill College Avenue, as well as skyscrapers such as the famous **Place Ville Marie**.
- ✓ Another must-see is the modern architecture of the new **Quartier international**.
- ✓ The Victorian era **Golden Square Mile** will be discussed.
- ✓ Cross through **Mount Royal Park**, where you will have access to a stunning view of the city.
- ✓ You will be impressed by the grandeur of the **Saint-Joseph Oratory**, one of the world's most significant pilgrimage sites.
- ✓ On the **Plateau Mont-Royal**, in the **Latin Quarter** and along **Saint-Laurent Boulevard**, you will learn more about the different ethnic groups that have helped shape our city.
- ✓ Drive by **Montréal's Harbour** and get on the eastside to the **Olympic Park**, site of the 1976 Summer Olympic Games. There will be time for a photo stop of the Olympic Stadium and the Montréal Tower, the world's highest inclined tower in the world. You will also drive by the Botanical Garden.
